





1. Inside the trunk, on the passenger side, locate and remove the access panel for the battery. Disconnect the negative battery cable. NOTE: Vehicle shown is a convertible.



2. Release the spring clamp securing the resonator tube to the 90 deg. Fitting and then disconnect the tube. Depress the locking tab and then disconnect the crank case vent hose.




3. Loosen the two hose clamps that secure the factory intake tube and then remove the intake tube from the vehicle.



4. Disconnect Mass air flow sensor electrical connection and then lift and remove the complete air filter housing from the vehicle.

NOTE: Airaid recommends that customers do not discard factory air intake.



5. Be sure that all three mounting grommets are still in the proper place and not still attached the factory air filter housing.



6. Using a T50 TORX, remove the two bolts securing the sound resonator to the front of the engine.


7. Locate and disconnect the sound tube retainers on the strut tower brace and A/C line.



8. At the firewall, Remove the 6mm flange nut that secures the sound tube to the firewall. Turn the tube ½ turn clockwise and the remove the tube from the vehicle.



9. Install the provided plug into the sound tube hole.




10. Remove the air box inlet from the factory air filter housing and install it onto the AIRAID air filter housing.



11. Install the provided air filter housing bracket onto the AIRAID air filter housing and then install the provided mounting stud onto the bracket as shown.



12. Install the radius filter adapter into the AIRAID filter housing and secure with the provided hardware.



13. Remove the mass air sensor from the factory air filter housing and install it into the AIRAID intake tube with the provided hardware. Install the provided crank case grommet into the AIRAID intake tube as shown.



14. Install the AIRAID decal onto the intake tube as shown.



15. Cut the clamp that secures the PCV chamber into the factory intake tube and then remove the chamber from the tube.



16. Install the PCV chamber into the grommet previously installed into the AIRAID intake tube as shown.



17. Install the AIRAID filter housing into the vehicle so that the mounting posts are engaged into the factory filter housing mounting grommets.



18. Install the coupler houses and hose clamps onto the AIRAID intake tube but do not tighten the clamps. Install the intake tube assembly onto the filter adapter and throttle body. Adjust the assembly for best fit and then secure all the hose clamps.



19. Connect the crank case vent hose to the PCV vent chamber and connect the mass air sensor electrical connection.



20. Install the AIRAID air filter onto the filter adapter and secure with the provided hose clamp.



21. Install the provided gasket onto the air filter housing lid.

22. Install the air filter housing lid onto the AIRAID air filter housing and secure with the provided hardware.



23. Double check your work!

Make sure there is no foreign material in the intake path. Make sure all clamps, hoses, bolts, and screws are tight. Double check the hood clearance!

Reconnect the negative battery cable!

Do Not Oil

Synthamax Air Filters do not require oil. Service air filter as needed by cleaning with common non-petroleum all-purpose household cleaner and water. Simple Green®, Formula 409® or equivalent works great. Apply cleaner to outside of air filter and allow to soak. Then flush filter clean from the inside out with a garden hose and repeat steps if necessary. Do not apply high pressure water or air to clean filter. Allow filter to air dry and reinstall.
