



# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Congratulations, you have purchased the finest air filter that money can buy. With proper care, this filter can last many seasons. This filter can be used in a stock machine, with no modifications required. If any engine modifications have been made tuning/jetting adjustments may be required. There are special installation instructions, so please follow the procedures outlined below to ensure the K&N® air filter seals properly.

### INSTALLATION:

1. Remove the seat to gain access to the air box. Follow the applicable instructions based on the type of air box you have. If the air box looks like Fig. 1, continue. If the air box looks like Fig. 4, skip to Step 4.
2. Remove the air box lid. (Fig. 2)
3. Loosen the hose clamp and remove the filter. Install the K&N® filter using the supplied hose clamp and fully tighten. (Figs. 2 & 3) Skip to Step 7.
4. To gain access to the air box, remove the inlet (See the arrow in Fig.4) by pulling it off the tube.
5. Remove the air box lid and pull the OEM filter out of the air box. (Fig. 5)
6. Install the K&N® filter in the air box (do not use the included hose clamp). (Fig. 6)
7. Re-install the air box lid and reverse the above steps to complete the installation.

**THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.**

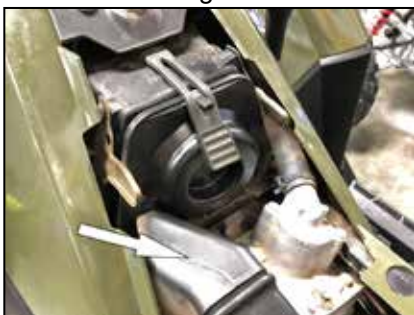
