Congratulations, you have purchased the finest air filter that money can buy. With proper care, this filter will last 1 million miles or more. This filter can be used in a stock machine, with no modifications required. If any engine modifications have been made tuning/jetting adjustments may be required. There are special installation instructions, so please follow the procedures outlined below to ensure the K&N Filtercharger® seals properly.

INSTALLATION:

1. Carefully lift and remove the engine cover from the vehicle. **(Fig 1)**
2. Release the two indicated airbox clips. **(Fig 2)**
3. Ease the 2 halves of the airbox apart and carefully slide out the original air filter. **(Fig 3)**
4. Remove any debris collected in the bottom of the airbox, (using a vacuum cleaner is good for this). **(Fig 4)**
5. Liberally grease the indicated lip sealing edge of the K&N filter, this is to aid filter fitment. **(Fig 5)**
6. Fit the K&N element into the airbox and slide firmly home. **(Fig 6)**
7. Ensure the 2 parts of the airbox are still connected at the base, then reclip the 2 halves of the airbox together. **(Fig 7)**
8. Refit the engine cover. **(Fig 8)**

THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.

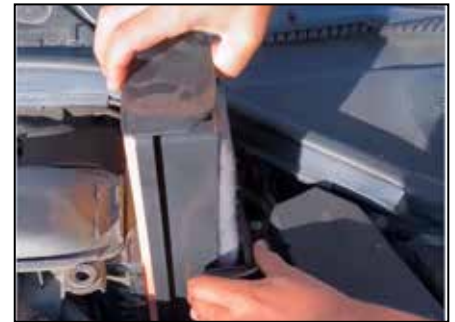
