#### INSTALLATION:

- 1. Remove the stock filter.
- 2. Wipe out any dirt or dust that may be inside the air filter housing.
- 3. Apply a layer of the supplied sealing grease on the o-ring around the inlet (FIGS.1 & 2)
- 4. Wipe off any excess grease from the inlet.

5. Install the K&N Filtercharger into the air box. Insert the filter at an angle so that the three posts engage the hinges in the air box. (FIG 3)

- 6. Using the two stock screws, secure the K&N Filtercharger to the air box. (FIG 4)
- 7. Re-install the air box lid to complete the installation.

8. Clean an area on the air box and apply the K&N Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others, who may be working on this vehicle, that this is a washable/re-usable air filter.

### THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.
