K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10-year/Million Mile Limited Warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

- 1. Open the glove box and locate support on the left side. Fig 1.
- 2. Disconnect the support and push down on the left and right tabs towards the back of the glove box to lower the glove box door. Fig 2
- 3. With glove box lowered, locate cabin filter housing door, and remove Fig. 3
- 4. Remove cabin filter and tray Fig 4
- 5. Remove cabin filter from tray.

NOTE: When removing filter, take care not to break tabs on sides of the tray Fig. 5 & Fig 6

- 6. Install K&N cabin filter into tray with K&N logo and part number facing the right side of the tray. Fig 7, 8 & 9
- 7. Reverse steps 1-4 to complete the cabin filter installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area and apply the K&N Stop Decal. The decal with help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter. **NOTE:** Angle the filter to get one edge under the tabs on one side. Gently bend the other end of the filter under the tabs.




