K&N[®] Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N[®] cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10-year/Million Mile Limited Warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N[®] cabin air filter.

1. Open glove box. Fig 1 & Fig 2

If your glove box looks like Fig 1, proceed to Step 2. If your glove box looks like Fig 2, you will need to push down on both tabs on the back of the glove box to release. See Fig 3. Proceed to Step 5.

2. Locate and remove access panel in the cup holder. Fig 4

- 3. Reach in to push on side of glove box to release. Fig 5 & 6
- 4. Lower glove box completely to gain access to cabin filter housing.
- 5. Locate and remove cabin filter housing cover Fig 7
- 6. Remove dirty cabin air filter. Clean any dirt of debris that might be present. Fig 8.

7. Install K&N Cabin Air filter into cabin filter housing. Note: be sure to tuck filter pull strap into the housing. Fig. 9

8. Reverse steps 1-4 to complete the installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area on the cabin housing and apply the K&N Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a re-usable cabin filter.
