K&N<sup>®</sup> Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filter.

- 1. Open the hood and locate the cabin air filter panel on the passenger side. (Fig. 1)
- 2. Unlock the quarter turn fastners to remove the panel to gain access to the cabin filter housing. (Fig. 1 & 2)
- 3. Remove the nut to detach the cabin air filter housing. (Fig. 3 & 4)
- 4. Remove the dirty cabin air filter from the housing. Clean any debris that might be present inside the housing. (Fig. 5)
- 5. Install the K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filter into the housing. (Fig. 6) NOTE: The K&N cabin air filter only fits in one direction.
- 6. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete the cabin filter installation. With the K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin filter installed, clean an area and apply the K&N<sup>®</sup> Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.
