K&N<sup>®</sup> Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filter.

- 1. Locate the cabin filter housing.
- 2. Remove the screw(s) that secure the cabin filter housing lid.
- 3. Remove the cabin filter from the cabin filter housing. Fig 1.
- 4. Remove any debris that might be present inside the cabin filter housing.
- 5. Install the K&N<sup>®</sup> Cabin Filter. The cabin filter will only fit in one direction, ensure that the pull tab features are facing out from the opening in the cabin filter housing.

NOTE: It may be necessary to gently rock the K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin filter up or down to ensure good fitment into the cabin filter housing. The edge of the filter will sit flush with the opening of cabin filter housing when installed correctly. Fig. 2, Fig. 3 & Fig. 4

- 6. Reinstall the screw(s) securing the lid onto the cabin filter housing.
- 7. Once the cabin filter is installed, clean an area on the housing and apply the K&N<sup>®</sup> Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.
