INSTALLATION:

1.) Remove the OE filter from airbox by removing the 4 screws retaining the airbox lid. Once removed, pull out the o-ring from the air filter housing lid. (Fig.1 - 3)

2.) Remove the dirty air filter from housing. (Fig.4)

NOTE: remove any dirt or debris that may be present in the filter housing.

3.) Once filter has been removed, pull out the o-ring from the air filter housing. (Fig.5)

NOTE: The 2 o-rings for the OE filter will NOT be used with the K&N air filter.

- 4.) Install the K&N air filter into the air filter housing.
- 5.) Reverse steps 1 & 2 to complete the air filter installation.

THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.
